

Selective Dry Cow Therapy

New Module in DairyComp


DairyComp has a new module that allows producers to implement, manage and monitor Selective Dry Cow Therapy (sDCT) programs on farm.

The easy to use module allows for the customization of the cow selection protocols based on accepted and validated approach of using Somatic Cell Count (SCC) history as well as clinical mastitis events.

NOTE: It is highly recommended that any herd considering sDCT have a consultation with their veterinarian to review Best Management Practices and potential risk areas.

After the sDCT module is setup, the **Cows Due to Dry** list can be modified to add a reference to the recommended dry off protocol to follow for each cow (i.e. treatment or no treatment). Retrospective analysis and monitoring can also easily be done through fresh cow SCC and mastitis incidence analysis.
